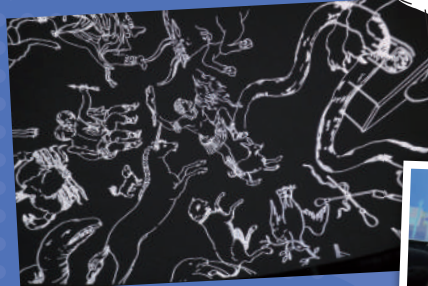

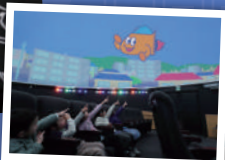

**[Iwateken Kotsu Bus]**

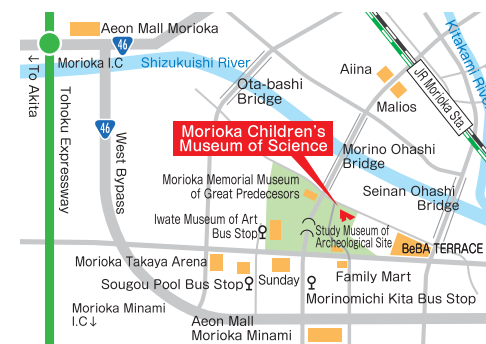
Take the Morioka Minami Loop bus

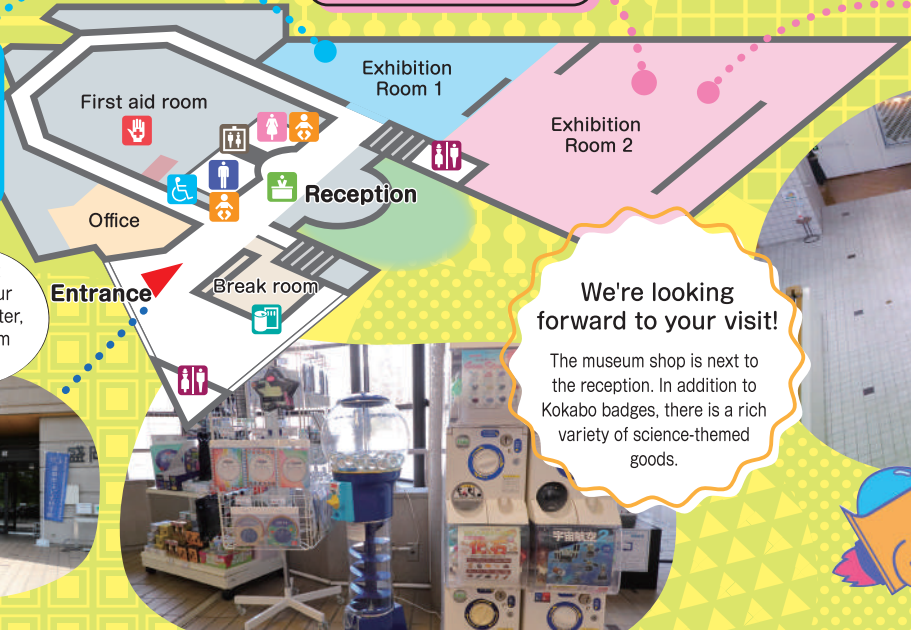
